

Getting to recenterspace

recenterspace address 31 Beach Rd. Ossining, NY 10562

Closest Train Stations: Ossining <u>Metro North</u> and Croton Harmon (both <u>Metro North</u> and <u>Amtrak</u>)

Closest airport: HPN/WESTCHESTER/WHITE PLAINS

Take a cab! ~ 30 mins - (maybe \$50-75 fare)

NYC Airports (all are roughly same commute time, depending on traffic)

Some are easier via public transit than others.

Getting here from all NYC area airports (LGA/Laguardia, JFK, EWR/Newark):

Cab: 60-180 minutes, \$150-\$200

Public Transit from LGA/Laguardia: (~\$25 one way) Take the <u>Select Bus Service M60</u> from LGA to *Harlem/125th St. Metro North Station* - from Harlem/125th take ANY <u>Northbound Hudson Line</u> train to *Ossining Station*.

This should take somewhere between 75 and 95 mins. (by the way only use google maps for this route, MTA site is ridiculous and takes an hour longer!)

*one thing to note is that you need to buy your fare for this bus ahead of time which should be possible at the bus stop at the airport - or use OMNY tap to pay https://www1.nyc.gov/html/brt/html/about/paying-fare.shtml

Public Transit from JFK: Airtrain from JFK to Jamaica, Queens. (\$5 one way) From Jamaica Station there are a few options:

Option 1: about 2 + hours travel time including Airtrain from JFK, about \$18-22 one way including Airtrain ticket NYC Subway <u>E train to 6 train</u> into Manhattan's <u>Grand Central</u>, then <u>Metro North Hudson</u> Line from Grand Central to Ossining Station.

Option 2: altogether about 2 + hours travel time including Airtrain from JFK - \$29-\$32 one way including Airtrain Ticket

Occasionally the travel time aligns to also access Amtrak. In this case, you can take Long Island Railroad from Jamaica, Queens to Penn Station. Then Amtrak Empire Service from Penn Station to Croton Harmon Station.

*note - you should definitely buy an Amtrak ticket in advance to save on cost.

Public Transit from EWR/Newark: again depending on timing there are two options:

<u>Airtrain Newark</u> to *Newark Airport Station*. From there, NJ Transit <u>Northeast Corridor Line</u> to NYC *Penn Station*. (\$15.50 one way)

From Penn Station: either:

Amtrak *Empire Line* to *Croton Harmon Station* (\$16 one way) OR NYC *Subway* from Penn Station to *Grand Central* (various ways to do this) and then from Grand Central take a *Hudson Line* train to *Ossining Station*. (\$14-18 one way)

Altogether around 1.5-2+ hours travel time

One more Airport Option if it happens to work out:

Stewart International Airport in New Windsor NY -

Cab from Stewart: about an hour travel time (likely almost no traffic), maybe \$75-\$100 one way
